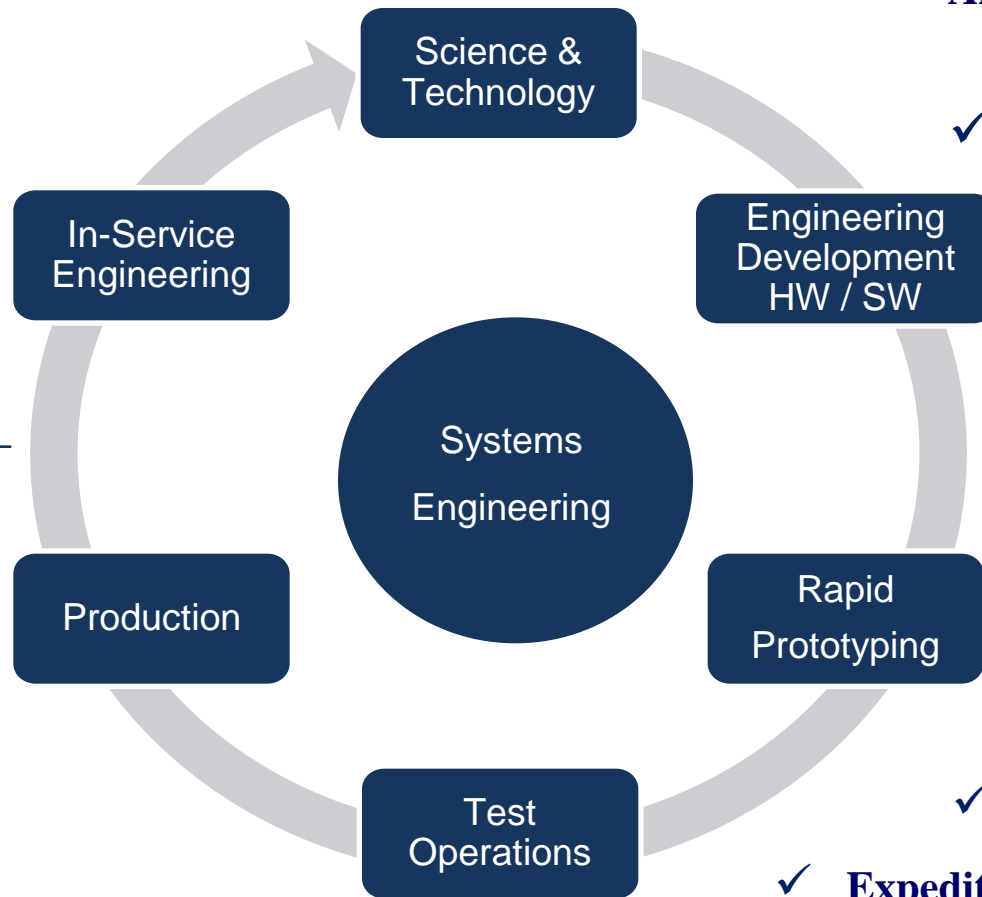

SMALL BUSINESS PROGRAM OVERVIEW



What is a small business

As defined in the Code of Federal Regulations (13 CFR 121) and the Federal Acquisition Regulations (Part 19) a small business must:

- Be organized for profit
- Have a place of business located in the United States or its outlying areas
- Make a significant contribution to the U.S. economy through payment of taxes and/or use of American products, material and/or labor
- Must meet the size standard (including its affiliates) specified in the solicitation (NOTE: all Non-manufacturers are limited to 500 employees no matter what NAICS Code and size standard are used in the solicitation)
- CAN A BUSINESS BE CONSIDERED BOTH SMALL AND OTHER THAN SMALL?



Affiliation

Small Business Administration (SBA) determines affiliation based on control. SB concerns and entities are affiliates of each other when one controls or has the power to control the other, or a third party or parties controls or has the power to control both. It does not matter whether control is exercised, so long as the power to control exists.

Some examples of affiliations:

- **Ownership (including stock ownership and stock options)**
- **Management (common management between companies)**
- **Previous relationships with ties or another concern (spin-offs)**
- **Economic dependency**

Affiliation (cont)

**Example of Affiliations:
One person owns the following:
100% of a flower shop
50% of a machine shop
75% of a retail store**

None of these companies do business with one another.

Are they affiliated?

**YES they are because one person has control of all of them.
Therefore when figuring out whether you meet a size standard or not
you must calculate the size based on the entire group and not one any
individual entity**



What are NAICS? PRONOUNCED "NAKES"

- A system for classifying products & services
- Classifies products/services into 20 different sectors and assigns each a 6-digit code
- In practice, a NAICS Code tells the contractor what we are buying
- Contractors use NAICS Codes to describe the kinds of work they perform:
 - A contractor can have more than one NAICS Code (max of 1000)
 - Their "primary NAICS Code" is for the activity that generates the most revenue for them
 - The contractor does not have to list the designated NAICS Code in the SAM in order to submit a proposal or to be awarded the contract

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN NAICS CODES & SMALL BUSINESS SIZE STANDARDS

- **NAICS Codes don't distinguish between small & large businesses**
- **13 CFR Part 121.102 explains how SBA determines small business size standards**
- **Size is a function of either annual revenue or number of employees, there is only one size standard for each NAICS Code**
- **The Table of Small Business Size Standards can be found on the SBA's Office of Size Standards web site**
 - **www.sba.gov/size**
 - **Note: The Non-Manufacturer's Rule limits the Small Business Size Standard to 500 employees**



Small Business Classifications

- **Small Business (SB)**
- **Woman-Owned Small Business (WOSB) and Economically Disadvantaged Women Owned Small Business (EDWOSB)**
- **Small and Disadvantaged Business (SDB)**
 - Including “8(a)” concerns
- **Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB)**

NOTE THERE IS NO PREFERENCE BETWEEN SOCIO ECONOMIC CATEGORIES



Set-aside Programs

REMEBER, in order to do any sort of set aside:

- **Rule of Two!**
- **At least 50% of the effort must be completed by a Small Business or it must supply the end item of another Small Business.**
- **Mandatory sources must be considered:**
 - **Federal Prison Industries**
 - **Ability One (Javits-Wagner-O'Day, NIB/NISH)**



Like Entities – Increase of Non-Manufacturer's Rule

- These pieces of legislation are tied to the same FAR Case (2016-011). Includes SBA's regulatory clarifications concerning application of the limitations on subcontracting, non-manufacturer rule, and size determination of joint ventures
- SBA finalized their rule in June 2016
- As of today, the FAR has not yet been updated to reflect any changes to Clause 52.219-14, Limitations on Subcontracting
- Until the FAR is updated, we will follow the current FAR regulations, which state under a Small Business Set Aside, the prime contractor must do at least 50% of the effort or provide the end item of another small business
- FAR Case (2016-011) was updated on 3/30/2018. Current status states that a draft interim FAR rule has been sent to the Office of Federal Procurement Policy for review



REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION (RFI) AND SOURCES SOUGHT ANNOUNCEMENTS



Tips for Responding to a Request for Information/Sources Sought Announcements

- **Tips**

- **Show holistic capability – technical, but also management practices, financial stability, quality processes, able to manage subcontractors, discriminators, etc.**
- **Provide more detail on number of employees and company locations**
- **Show how you will minimize transition risk**
- **Request clarification, if needed**
- **Meet the response timeline**



Request for Information (RFI)/Sources Sought Responses

- **Areas where industry can improve**
 - Answer all the questions
 - Be sure you are addressing a NAVAIR requirement and not one from another agency or service
 - Be sure to discuss all the items that will be evaluated
 - Address only experience that is applicable to the requirement
 - Validate your claims of capability
 - If you combine past performance contracts, be sure to provide a break out of scope and complexity of each
 - If you propose teaming, show value-added
 - Address how you will manage subcontractors and prior experience in this area
 - If admitting lack of capability or experience; offer solution, mitigation, alternative, etc.



Government Feedback on RFI/Sources Sought Responses

- **Show interest in wanting to propose a requirement but don't identify any barriers to accomplishing the requirement or alternative solutions for accomplishing the requirement**
- **Fail to follow the instructions and provide what was requested in the synopsis**
- **Don't provide just a generalized "line card" or a specification sheet (unless it's a commercial buy)**
- **If we ask for your capabilities you should provide a narrative illustrating some of your experience with the type of work we're looking for**
- **If you performed similar contracts, provide the contract numbers and point of contacts so we can go look them up**



Government Feedback on RFI/Sources Sought Responses (cont)

- If the RFI is looking for design of something your response should include a basic type of approach, such as “we have widget X that meets several specifications but not all; however, widget X can be modified (describe actions) to meet your specifications. We have experience making those types of modifications as illustrated by our successful performance under contracts...
- If the RFI includes a draft RFP or any portion of draft specifications, you should be asking questions, point out inconsistencies or missing information that will be needed for you to prepare your proposal. Also discuss any known industry-standard or –driven alternatives where appropriate
- Discuss any area of the specification that is confusing
- Discuss data deliverables from the perspective of burden of providing information such as duplication in the data, any data rights or licensing issues or if there is anything we should be requesting that isn't there



Government Feedback on RFI/Sources Sought Responses (cont)

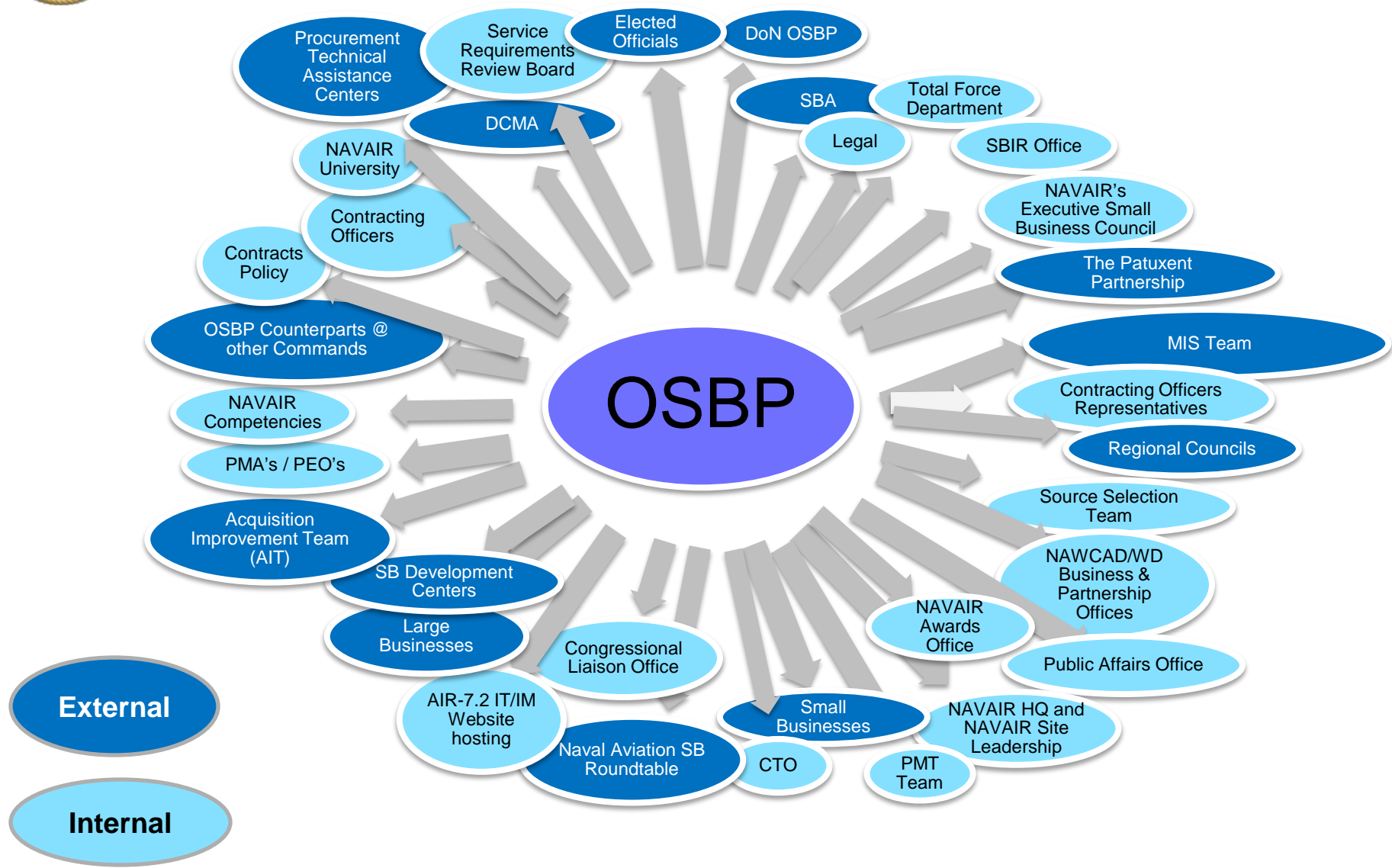
- Point out if there are commercial items that either exist to meet the need or if they can easily be modified for our use
- Discuss areas that could be cost drivers.
- Discuss if there are quantity discounts that may be taken advantage of
- Discuss if there are any issues with the requirements in terms of producibility/achievability
- Discuss the technology readiness level
- Discuss teaming (include Mentor Protégé, Joint Ventures, etc.)
- Showing interest at the RFI/sources sought stage and then not providing a proposal when the solicitation is issued. If you respond to the RFI/Sources Sought but decide not to submit a proposal let us know why

If you know a full and open competition is pending or you see a full and open competition synopsis and you think there are **2** or more SDVOSBs, 8(a)s, HUBZones, or WOSBs, or small businesses that can do the work, **LET US KNOW!**

Work closely with the contract specialist and the site small business deputy.

Industry Day

- **Industry Day goals:**
 - Communicate our requirements and plan with industry
 - Seek interest and input from industry to support decision on acquisition and industry capabilities
- **Industry Days are held before the actual announcement of the procurement and before any solicitation is released**
- **Industry Days can provide valuable information to assist in the determination of what type of contractors are in the marketplace, what technology exists and gives us a chance to hear contractor questions and concerns about our requirement**

An Industry Day is not the same as a trade show or pre-solicitation/procurement conference.



Guidance To Industry

- **Company Data Sheet** - required prior to meeting with NAVAIR OSBP
 - No more than three pages (MS Office document) about your company and products or services
 - **Tailored for NAVAIR**
 - Keep it simple, but make your company stand out
- **Answer the following**
 - Company point of contact information
 - Describe what your company does (products or services)
 - How your mission relates to Naval Aviation
 - Product commercially available?
 - Intellectual property rights?
 - Product utilized with or on any other DoD, government, or commercial platform?
 - Quantitative data on product performance
 - Small business certifications, current contract vehicles and NAICS

Capability Statements

- **KNOW YOUR CUSTOMER**
 - Don't use a generic Capability Statement or line card
 - Should be tailored to the customer you're meeting with
 - Should highlight what you've done in the past
 - Include any special technology or processes that you know the customer needs
 - Just because you built something for one DoD Agency doesn't mean it's compatible with another DoD Agency requirement. For instance, just because you built something for an Air Force aircraft doesn't mean the same equipment will work on a Navy aircraft. Know the environment the equipment will be used in. Navy equipment has requirements such as vibration test and environmental differences than the Air Force because the Navy equipment will be exposed to an Aircraft Carrier (vibration of the ship and salt water environment)

After Contract Award

- Key message: You must now PERFORM!
- LET NAVAIR KNOW if you're experiencing difficulties... ASAP
 - Technical/Performance
 - Schedule
 - Financial
- ...And these communications should be DOCUMENTED
- Know your CONTRACT...scope, terms, conditions, schedules, deliverables – it's what we're holding you accountable for
- Be aware the government rates your performance yearly in the Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) – Used in future source selections (Contracts over \$1M for services and over \$5M for products)

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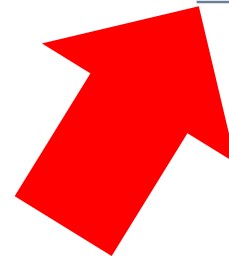
